III. LIBR 3000E: Zotero 5.0: The “Killer App” (Location: Brenda Wallace Computer Room)

Content: Once you have identified relevant references, Zotero 5.0 allows you to quickly save them on your desktop using a connector for Chrome or Firefox. Then, you can incorporate them into a paper you are writing *in almost any format you choose*—APA, MLA, Chicago, Vancouver and many more. Zotero 5.0 also generates a bibliography of the references you have used at the end of your paper. *This is the one tool fourth year students wish they had heard about in first year.* [We recommend you bring your laptop to this session with an installed version of Chrome or Firefox as well as Microsoft Office.
