Biographical Note: Mr. Fraser, while employed by The International Nickel Co. of Canada (INCO), served as a steward, and was associated with Local 6500 of the United Steelworkers of America (U.S.W.A.) from 1969-1972.

Scope and content: This fonds attests to Alfred Fraser's involvement to the mining labour movement in Sudbury. More specifically informs us as to Canadian U.S.W.A. policies on the discharging of a mine steward's duties and functions. Steward's material in the form of handbooks, collective bargaining agreements, and booklets on labour policies, mine operations and health and safety issues reveals the extent of these duties. Some of the papers deal with training programs associated with stewardship, and researchers may find the printed material from The Labour College of Canada of note.

The fonds consists of general correspondence, reports, Stewards' Handbooks, Canadian Department of Labour and Economic Council of Canada booklets, newsletters, memoranda of the Labour College of Canada and several copies each of the newspapers *Dasein*, *The Searcher* and *The Financial Post* (1970 - 1971).

Note: **Immediate source of Acquisition:** The fonds was donated prior to 1982 to N.O.L.I.A., the holdings of which were later transferred to the Laurentian University Archives.
