Biographical sketch: Zepha Trevorrow was a resident of Denver, Colorado, USA. Her husband Ed, prospector, travelled through Northern Ontario in 1911. They had a daughter named Virginia.

Scope and Content: The Zepha Trevorrow fonds consists of 15 postcards and two letters, that Ed Trevorrow sent to his wife while in Northern Ontario in 1911. The pictures of the postcards, signed by W. Peters, depict the South Porcupine 1911 fire, and early mines settlements of the same area. The content of the postcards and letters, give insights on the life of a gold prospector in Northern Ontario for the early 1900's.
