Biographical sketch: Catharine Dixon (1927-) moved to Elliot Lake in 1957, and, since then, has been a very active member of the community by serving on a wide variety of community boards, committees and organizations. While continuing to be involved in different activities of the United Church, she was elected to the first Public School Board in 1966. For the period 1980-1987, she also served as a member of the Elliot Lake Police Commission.

In the 1970s, Catharine Dixon worked as a reporter for the Sault Star. She wrote short histories of the United Church and of the Elliot Lake Police Force. In 1997, she published "The Power and the Promise." Her latest publication is entitled "As it Happened" (2001). Both are about Elliot Lake.

Scope and Content: The Catharine Dixon fonds consists mainly of handwritten notes, newspaper clippings, reports and minutes. The documentation files cover different aspects of the history of Elliot Lake. Among the subjects, are the economic activities, the demography and the politics of Elliot Lake. The files were created by Catharine Dixon, while researching for her book "The Power and the Promise".
